The main positive point you can take away from your essay is that you have correctly used words such as 'conviction', 'affects', 'encourage', 'essential', 'drawbacks', 'benefits' and 'enrich', which will put across the fact that you are a strong candidate.

Aside from looking at the feedback I have given, and taking more practice tests, I would recommend that you focus on ending sentences when there is a change in topic, and also exploring **passive vs active** sentence constructions. Try to utilise the **active** more frequently, whilst remaining aware of the passive. You should also aim to write a slightly longer response as 253 is only 3 words over the minimum.
